North Somerset offers a co-ordinated admissions scheme (see above), which our school adheres to. The Admission Number for the school is 15 per year group, and this is the number of places normally available within each year group. Should the school be over-subscribed with applications, allocation of places will be made in accordance with North Somerset Council’s over-subscription criteria.

There is comprehensive programme of induction for all children entering Flax Bourton Church of England Primary School for the first time. This induction programme aims to provide a secure and happy start for each child as they take their first steps in school and to lay a firm foundation for their future development.
